


Year 1 - Autumn 1 Land Ahoy!

Being responsible

At the end of this theme, children should...

- Know the names of the five oceans and can locate them on a map.
- Know how to locate the seas and oceans surrounding the UK.
- Know where coasts are found and can explain what a coast is.
- Know how to identify the physical features of a coast (beach, cliff, coast, sea).
- Know how to identify human features on the coast (port, harbour)
- Know how to mix secondary colours
- Know how to apply knowledge of colour mixing when painting.
- Know how to explore colour when printing.
- Know how to experiment with paint mixing to make a range of secondary colours.
- Know how to apply their painting skills when working in the style of an artist.




Have a Pirate Day! Ask the chidlrer to consider seeing a coast in the difference and imagine landing on it. Could experience a sensory walk?
