- Improvise and compose music for a range of purposes using the inter-related dimensions of music
- Listen with attention to detail and recall sounds with increasing aural memory
- Use and understand staff and other musical notations
- Appreciate and understand a wide range of high-quality live and recorded music drawn from different traditions and from great composers and musicians
- Develop an understanding of the history of music

- Develop listening skills and be able to talk about music with confidence
- Understand the elements or components of music and begin to explore and experiment with these
- Play and perform
- Develop cultural and historical awareness
- Develop social and emotional skills
