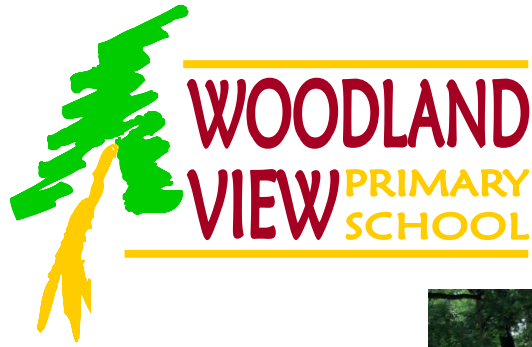

SAVE THE ANIMALS



This project was initiated by two ex-pupils, and we are keen to keep it going

What do we want?

We care about beautiful animals that are in danger of becoming extinct. We want our school to raise money to help save them. We can do this through animal sponsorship with World Wildlife Fund (WWF).



What are we doing?

We have organised a "Save the Animals Day" on Friday 6th October. All children will have an endangered animal session in the Immersive Room.



What will happen?

All children across the school are asked to come to school dressed like an animal. If you don't have an animal costume you can just wear the colours of your favourite animal. All children are asked to bring in £1 on that day.

How will we use the money?

Each year group has 60 children so we hope to get £60 for each year group. That money will sponsor one animal for a year. We will get information from the WWF about our animal. Each year group will sponsor a different animal:

- FS Asian Elephant
- Y1 Lion
- Y2 Jaguar
- Y3 Black Rhino
- Y4 Orang Utan
- Y5 Bengal Tiger
- Y6 Snow Leopard
