Dear Parents,

As we are learning about the Romans this term, we are excited to let you know that we have organised a trip to **the Verulamium Museum in St Albans**. The children will be able to explore the museum, as well as exploring the grounds and handling Roman artefacts in an organised handling session.

The cost of the trip is £14.50 which includes the coach and entrance to the museum, as well as a variety of on-site activities. If payment is an issue please contact Mr Thomas in confidence. For further information on voluntary contributions please see the school website.

The trip to the **Verulamium Museum** will take place on **Wednesday 28th March**. The coach will depart **promptly** from school at **9:30 am**. We expect to be back at school by **4:15pm** (please note that this is later than the end of the school day). Please do not book a hot school meal for this day.

We ask that for the visit the children wear school uniform along with suitable attire for the weather (for example a rain coat) and that you provide them with a packed lunch which will need to be carried in a **named plastic bag**. There might be time to visit the gift shop therefore your child can bring a maximum of £5 to spend if they wish. Children must keep their money in a named wallet or purse and it will be their responsibility throughout the day.
